

Top Things You Should Know About D.U.I.

If you have been stopped for a DUI:

- Have your registration, driver's license, and proof of insurance handy so you can easily provide them to the officer
- You have the power but not the right to refuse to take any field tests the officer may offer but be aware that your refusal may be used against you later
- Inform the officer of any medical conditions which may affect your ability to do field tests
- Ask to speak to an attorney
- Politely decline to answer questions unless your attorney is present
- If you are arrested, submit to a test of your breath or blood - not before
- If a sample of your blood is taken, ask for an independent test as well - **DO NOT WAIVE THIS RIGHT**

- Do not admit fault

- Get the names and contact information of any witnesses - do not depend on the police to do it for you
- Take photographs of the vehicles, your injuries and the damage if you can
- Exchange insurance information with the other driver(s)
- Report the accident to your insurance company

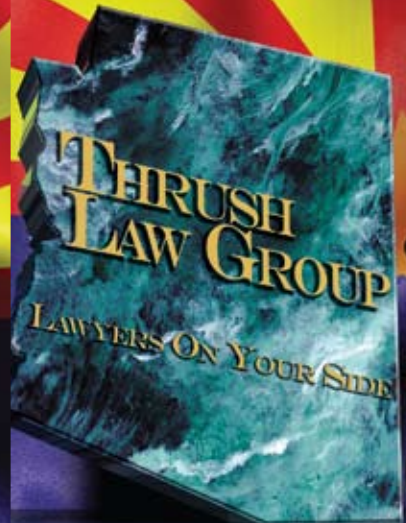
